Residential Services

Residential Services Provide:

- Genuine homes in typical neighbourhoods
- Respite for families/supported individuals
- Home-sharing with families/individuals
- Opportunities for community inclusion

Residential Services Include:

Apartment Programs/ Supported Living

Weekly visits are made available to persons living in their own apartments or suites in the community so that they can receive assistance in maintaining and enhancing their independence. Support includes assistance with meals, shopping, budgeting, medications, appointments and relationship-building.

Semi-Independent/ Transitional homes

Lightly staffed homes are available for persons who desire more independence and/or are working toward independent living. Support focuses on developing independent living skills and building upon existing strengths.

24-Hour Supported Homes

Fully staffed residences are available for persons who require more intensive daily support. Support varies according to the needs of the individuals in the home and may include personal care, health planning and support and psychiatric and/or behavioural support.

Host Family Services

MAPCL contracts with families/persons in the community who want to open their homes and invite a person with a developmental disability to live with them. This service provides a more natural alternative to staffed residences.

Respite

Temporary stays at residences or with a host family are available for individuals with disabilities so that family members/caregivers can receive short-term breaks (e.g. 48 – 72 hours). On occasions, respite may also be provide in the family/caregiver's home.
